I told them, we would try to keep parking on the park side of the street and I stressed that we would not block any driveways or park to close to them. There are plenty of parking spaces just down the hill from the courts, where we won't impact anyone. Please try to respect the neighbors.

All play must also start after 8 AM because of the neighborhood CC& R's. If you are there early please play on the new courts away from the homes on the other end and please don't use the blower until after 9 AM.

Anyone can put out the white board or the sign in table and the ball buckets. We all take turns doing that and cleaning the tables now and then.

We took the blue tarp down and it gave us some shade over the hot summer months. We will be looking at some sun screens to put back up in the Spring. It is nice to sit in between games when the temperatures are up there!

The courts were finally **washed on August 19th** with the water broom after issues with water pressure at the hook up. They should be washed monthly, but we settled for every two months. They have only been washed once this year. We have asked **Lifetime Activities** for a schedule of cleaning, including blowing off weekly to be posted at the courts and are still waiting for our pickleball guideline signs which we hoped to get last year.
